Within the Gaza Strip, a delicate ceasefire is now in place, but 58 percent of Gaza remains inaccessible to Palestinians. Fewer than one hundred aid trucks are entering the Strip daily, with several days of complete closures since the agreement began on 10 October.

Operation Realife continues to help alleviate the suffering of Palestinians through our water distribution events. Throughout October, we distributed 180,000 liters of water to 60,000 people across nine communities. On eight separate occasions, we provided additional water trucks beyond our normal operations to help meet people's needs.

With the flow of some aid into Gaza, this rarely includes water. It is estimated that only ten to twenty percent of Gaza's water infrastructure remains functional. In the short term, the water crisis will persist until this critical infrastructure is repaired.
