

Operation Realife

I-002

The Harvest Initiative's are a vital part of Operation Realife's aid distribution program. I-002 launched on 13 Jan 2025. From launch day we were able to reach our goal in 55 days.

I-002's objective was to provide 100 Palestinian's who are either injured or seriously ill with financial agency. We distributed money to one hundred individuals in urgent need. The event itself took place on two separate days; 12 MAR 2025 and 20 MAR 2025.

Patients in hospitals often have to pay for their own meals in addition to treatments, medications, and other medical services. In most cases, these individual's were bed ridden and could not go online to ask people for support. Due to overcrowding in hospitals, lack of transportation, and safety concerns, many individual's end up being alone in the hospital for days or weeks at a time, with no way to get money.



One of our beneficiaries was a child with cerebral palsy. Unfortunately, he is an orphan as he lost all of his immediate family during the current conflict.

He is being supported by his aunt, but due to financial difficulties, she is unable to fully provide the required assistance. Your support has helped alleviate the suffering for him and helped ensure he can receive adequate treatment and sustenance for several weeks.

I-002 cost a total of \$15,728
